

Horticultural Section Rules

CHILLI CHALLENGE 2021

1. Competition is open to Professional Gardeners and Amateurs.
2. **PLEASE NOTE: FOR THE 2021 CHILLI CHALLENGE, NO MEMBERSHIP FEE IS PAYABLE BUT AN ENTRY FORM IS REQUIRED.**
3. All exhibits to be bona fide property of the exhibitor and be in his or her possession two months before the exhibition.
4. The prizes or awards to be decided by the Judge(s), who shall be practical gardeners and, in the event of a dispute arising, the Committee's decision shall be final and binding upon all exhibitors.
5. Competitors will receive from the Show Secretary, a card for each exhibit. The card should be placed by the exhibit with the name downwards. **THESE WILL BE AVAILABLE WHEN YOU ENTER YOUR CHILLI PLANT.**
6. Exhibits will be accepted at our **PLANT SALE** on **SUNDAY 26TH** September; **PLEASE HAND IN YOUR CHILLI PLANT BY 0830 (Open at 0730 for plant donations and entries)**
7. The Society will not be responsible for damage to plants etc. during the Exhibition.
8. Power is given to the Judges to withhold a prize if they deem the exhibit is not worthy and to award an extra prize in cases of outstanding merit.
9. Exhibitors may enter two exhibits. Prizes will be awarded; however, in 2021, no points or trophies will be awarded.
10. In the event that Covid restrictions do not allow Plant Sale to go ahead, we will accept entries by photograph.
