- 2. AP's from last meeting (4th May 2023)
- a. **Non-bee group usage of Bee Bothy** : Currently no non-TDG usage so decision to create policy on-hold.
- b. **Booking system for the 3 user groups of the Bee Bothy:** joint administration of all TDG groups currently being discussed at TDG level. Ideas of TBG admin that could be included should be emailed to DM.
- c. **Policy for extraction equipment usage / honey press:** extraction policy to be drafted **(AP:YD)**. Agreed to purchase additional sieves and price a heather press.
- d. Dates and topics for winter talks: Keep at one a month on a Sunday afternoon Starting at 2pm. Talk Topics: Top Bar Hives (TBD) and II(SL). Workshop topics: Prep of apideas (YD) and queenlessness (add to beginners and invite members (SL))
- e. Library review and lending guidelines: Working well and no issues with members returning books on a timely basis. Membership forms should include guidance on how to borrow books going forward. (AP:DM)
- 3. Apiary maintenance/management/gardener/sublimation/trickle.

The employment of a gardener has been hugely beneficial. Costs to date have been higher than budgeted because of the backlog of maintenance tasks but will be 4 hrs a month next season.

Agreed to continue with sublimination. Children not to be present.

4. Bee bothy – maintenance.

Agreed to assess and organise maintenance as and when required. Water to be switched off from now for winter period.

5. Teaching:

Once a fortnight over the summer worked well. Agreed to have a rota so 2 of the more experienced members are present. Starting 3pm.

6. Beginners:

Numbers to be capped at 10.

Those with passes at Basic Beemaster to be asked to help.

7. Library / book plates:

A January event to be organised to affix book plates into books (AP:DW)

8. Signs / school:

The Inchmarlo Community Shed have kindly made wooden pollinator/minibeast cut outs to be used as signage from the village to the apiary on open days. Tarland primary pupils to be asked to decorate them.

9. Visits:

In future members will be asked to assist at visits to the apiary thus ensuring sufficient helpers are available.

10. Work parties – gutters, barrels, weeding bee enclosure/ivy/slabs:

Work parties to be held for all above tasks except laying of slabs under hives around apiary – quotes to be obtained for this work. (AP:YD)

11. Swarm collection:

Agreed those wishing to be sent details of swarms available for collection should attend a training session first and agree to certain conditions. To be discussed further at next meeting.

12. Finance update: Current bank balance £1969. Income and expenditure summary be given at next meeting.
